1. a. Capt. John **Flood** (c. 1694, England – 1782, Buckingham Co., VA). m. 1) c. 1754 in England to Agatha **Davis** 2) c. 1762 in Buckingham Co., VA to Agnes **Payne**. John and Agnes are buried beneath the Buckingham Baptist Church, near Dillwyn, VA.

*The earliest document found on John was a land patent in Albemarle Co., VA on 3 March, 1760 for 30 shillings. John moved to Virginia after retiring from the British Navy where he was granted 295 acres in what would become Buckingham County. He served as Sexton of the Buckingham Baptist Church. (Buckingham County is now Appomattox County)

She was the daughter of Maj. Thomas **West** and Elizabeth **Bolling**. Joel and Elizabeth are buried in Flood Cemetery, "Old Home", Vera, Appomattox Co., VA.

1. d. U.S.Congressman Henry DeLaWarr **Flood** (14 Aug., 1816, Appomattox Co., VA – 21 Apr., 1892) m. 1) 1838 to Mary Elizabeth Trent (10 Jul., 1822 – 26 Jan., 1839); 2) Mary Elizabeth Strother **Flood**. Mary was the daughter of Thomas Henry and Martha **Flood**.

*Henry DeLaWarr was a lawyer, a Confederate officer in the Civil War, and a U.S. Congressman.

2. d. Eliza Bolling **Flood** (1820 –) m. 19 Nov., 1835 in Buckingham Co., VA to William A. **Poore**

2. b. William **Flood** (twin) (c. 1756 –). He died in the Revolutionary War.
3. b. Mary **Flood** (twin) (c. 1756 –). She died young.
4. b. John **Flood** (1757, Buckingham Co., VA. – Aug., 16, 1826, Buckingham Co., VA) m. 1) 1 Dec., 1788 to Mary **Fuqua** (c. 1760 – 26 May, 1816, Buckingham Co., VA). Mary was the daughter of William **Fuqua** and Mary **Ford**. 2) Amy ?.

*John was a Revolutionary War soldier.

He was member of the First and Second Confederate Congress Feb., 1862 to Mar., 1865 House of Representatives. As a Democrat, he was a member of seven US Congresses from 1847 to 1861.
